


Oily Cart Digital Archive Instructions








Oily Cart has been making shows since 1981. We have lots of photos, videos, music and **documents** from these shows. You can look at them in our Digital Archive.

All the content connected to what you have searched for will appear.


Click on a piece of content to explore it.

This time, Patrick Lynch directed it, with a few special differences. The sheep costumes were improved. The apparition of the palace was magical. Katherine Vernez showed the eerie awakening of the Queen to perfection. Sheema Mukherjee played the music beautifully on the sitar. A shower of rose petals accompanied the final ensemble celebratory dance (choreography by Debbie Bandara). It was so joyful that often the children joined the actors on the dance floor! If you clicked on a video, you will be able to click play to watch it.


If you clicked on audio, you will be able to press play to listen to it.








When you have finished with what you are looking at / listening to, you can go back to look at the other content. Click on the 'Back to archive' button.
